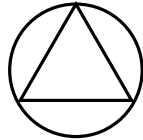

Adventures in Sobriety – “The Couches are Closed”

A few times I think of something to write but never actually sit and do it. This morning I had an overwhelming desire to do so—so I did.

I found out yesterday that the little meeting in Ormond that the “locals “ called the couches (Adventures in Sobriety) has closed its doors. It met Monday nights at 7:30 pm at the First United Methodist Church in Ormond Beach and it brings great memories to mind and sad feelings that it is no longer there.

I was 9 months sober and being dragged to meetings in basements and hidden places few people rarely knew about. I was the only girl there and was met shortly after 7:30 pm by another girl, we’ll call her “breeze.” They said that’s what she did—breeze in and breeze out—dead now---couldn’t put the drink down long enough for her cancer treatments to help her. As I sat in this meeting with only, as I recall, about 4 or 5 men eagerly willing to help the newcomer with the TRUTH, I began to add their Truth to my beginning program.

There were 129 years of sobriety there with only these few guys, WOW! Why do I remember this so well? It is because this is where I went for the truth. I was not to be petted and gently patted on the a** but the hard cold truth was told to me there. I have a FATAL ILLNESS that wants me DEAD.

Thank you to John D, Glenn Y, John R and Kenny S for helping me to grow into a strong new woman—this meeting will be missed. The message carried by this group will be passed along as best as I can.

**Our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio and films.**

Tradition 11 is more than a sound PR policy or a denial of self-seeking - it is a reminder that personal ambition has no place in AA. Telling the difference between attraction and promotion is not hard - lead by example and stay away from "advertising" AA to the public. When we maintain anonymity at the public level, we acknowledge that revealing our identities can also reveal the identities of friends or family, possibly putting them or their jobs in jeopardy. Practice humility by learning to: 'walk the walk' not 'talk the talk'.
