## Lost and Found



In April, a lost 11 year old missing for four days was found by a stranger. When asked about why he packed toilet paper, he said "I thought maybe I would leave markers so that I would be able to have a way back out." As the story would have it, he found her with seemingly effortless determination and blind faith. It's the pack of toilet paper he used that really inspires me.

Once upon a time, I too was lost, having been out in the alcoholic wilderness for far too long. Eventually, I was led to Alcoholics Anonymous and given four rolls of toilet paper. Barbara gave me my first. She had six years, loved going to meetings, and was very laid back. She taught me to get excited about meetings, my first "roll of toilet paper".

My relationship with Barbara ended and in great pain I was led to Christy – tough, cantankerous with 15 years of sobriety. She cracked her whip and herded me through the first four steps. Then after a personal crisis she became angry with the world and angry with me (or so it seemed). My relationship with Christy ended, but she taught me how to be disciplined about working the steps, my second "roll of toilet paper".

Laura came by way of my 5<sup>th</sup> step. She had five years more than me, was gentle yet tough, believed in meetings and steps, and worshiped at the altar of service. I finished my remaining steps with her and have always remained big on service - my third "roll of toilet paper".

In my 8th year, I stopped growing and felt lost again but not for long. Barbara who now has 24 years, holds me accountable and helps me apply the traditions – my fourth "roll of toilet paper".

So, just like the stranger at the beginning of this story, I have found there is much value in packing "toilet paper" so I can leave markers in my journey of sobriety. My "four pack" of meetings, steps, service and traditions never fail to lead me back out when I am lost.

From The Archives  
*Diary of Two Motorcycle Hobos*

In the Introduction of this book, Lois states that she thought it was a good idea for Bill and her to take a year off and explore his theories of investing in stocks although her reason was to get him away from New York, the “saloons and his buddies.” Lois kept an account of their travels and we have a copy of the published work in Archives.

Their trip starts at her parent’s house on Clinton St. in Brooklyn, NY. The first entry is near Poughkeepsie, NY on Thursday, April 16, 1925. Then there are several stories from “The Camp’” in Dorset, VT as well as places that they visited in upstate New York. Toward the end of September they head south stopping off in Egypt, PA but returned to New York for six weeks because of a family emergency. In early December it is back on the road again, heading south. They stop in Washington, DC and several cities in NC. By January they are in Atlanta, GA. In February there are stops in Florida including Jacksonville, Orlando, Winter Haven and Ft. Myers. They stay at various places in Florida until late April 1926 when they end up in Birmingham, AL.

In the last diary entry, they are in Muscle Shoals, AL on May 17, 1926. Bill and Lois have an accident with the motorcycle and the diary stops. The rest of the book is notes and stories added from memory by Lois in 1973.

### Good Sponsorship & The 4<sup>th</sup> Tradition

Lay out the facts. Encourage personal authenticity and strong commitment.

Respect their right to walk away. Not once do you pull rank and fall back on intimidation to get your way.

Let there be no question on where you stand. You have decided to stay sober, no question about it. Now it's their turn to decide for themselves.

Know where you are going, but give others the space they need to choose for themselves.

No threats. No name-calling. No public put-downs. No exploitation or manipulation or humiliation.

There will always be those who want you to make their decisions for them...to cosign for their lives. Don't do it.

Back off and say, "You decide." That's not only smart, it's an evidence of two admirable virtues: security in yourself and respect for the program of Alcoholics Anonymous.

If they don't wrestle with the issues on their own, the resulting decision might be a superficial commitment that might very well melt under the inevitable heat of difficulty and trial of life on life's terms.

It takes a commitment to the Fourth Tradition to withstand such tempting invitations to take control. It is helpful to remember that every time you yield to that destructive desire for power you retard your own and another's growth toward sobriety, emotional maturity and spiritual growth. Make the commitment today.

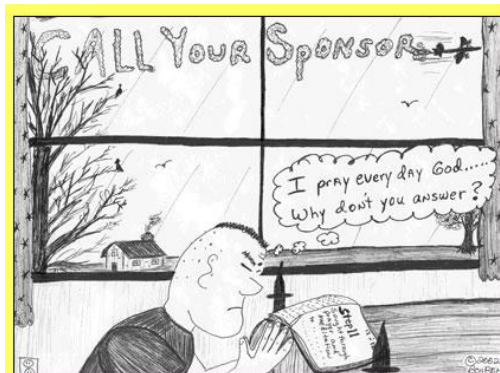
### ***Thumper's Corner*** **Am I An Alcoholic?**
