AFTER THE FROST

"You're thawing." That's what my sponsor said after I asked her tearfully, for the umpteenth time, why I seemed to cry at the drop of a hat. "Thawing?" I asked, tearfully, but with much curiosity. "Thawing." she confirmed quietly. When I first started working the Steps, I became very weepy. I couldn't understand it, because I was not a "crier". In fact, come to think of it, I couldn't remember the last time I had really had a good cry. Now, here I was, sober, and I couldn't keep a dry eye to save my life!

Today when I reflect on the early days, I know exactly what she meant. I had started drinking preteen and by the age of 18, I was a daily drinker. Along the way, tough things happened in my life, but I was numbed by alcohol. When something tragic happened, I froze my feelings in a drunken haze. As I cried, my tears were blended with drunkenness, anger, and self-pity. As the years went by, my heart froze beneath a thick block of "alcoholic" ice.

It's just like the frosts we've had this winter in Florida. After the frost, many of my cherished plants looked totally dead, but when I looked more closely I noticed green stalks under all those dead leaves. My plants would be all right. Just like my sponsor knew so long ago, that once I started thawing, I would be all right. Under all the dead leaves of hopelessness, my 'stalk' was still green. The Steps cut away the dead parts and the Program brought new shoots to bear in my life. After the frost, I started thawing. After the thaw, I started growing. Anon

From The Archives

When we receive an update to a group's history we like to publish the history again. The Wednesday Women's Group was included the Hi 'n Dry in 2001 and some of that information is included as well as information from histories submitted by Martha S. in 2003 and by Trish A. in January 2010.

The Wednesday Women's Group started on the first Tuesday in January 1975 at the Almous Club. Founders were Martha S, Virginia G. and Marge F (all now deceased) according to the history in 2003. The original Hi 'n Dry article says that the group was formed to support newcomer women and provide a place to communicate with other women about the personal areas of their lives. There is no mention of when it was changed from Tuesday to Wednesday.

Early members of the group were Mary Mc, Carol T, Martha B, Theresa M, Kathy F. and Jean G. Martha S. was treasurer for 14 yrs and Jean G. was secretary for many years as well. Trish A. and Shirley S. are the last of the "Early Members" still attending this meeting.

In 1987, the group moved to the Central Baptist Church on Fairview Avenue in Daytona Beach. The church remains the same although the meeting room has changed several times. The membership of the group has stayed between 25 and 30 for many years.

In 1992, Peggy K. had a special anniversary and asked the Rev. Hal Marchman to speak. This is the only time that a man has ever been to this meeting.

The Wednesday Women's Group is a strong group, active in service. They have representatives who participate in District meetings and IGR meetings. They support the Intergroup Office and its work in the AA community with regular contributions. Members volunteer to do their share at Intergroup activities such as the picnic, Oldtimers and Pasta dinners. This is indeed a group to be proud of.
