Just like there is no wrong way to do service in AA (just do it!) - there's no wrong way to meditate, just as long as I do it. As simple as this sounds, meditation did not come easily at first. My biggest challenge was sitting still. First, silence drove me crazy so I always had noise - TV, radio or the chatter of a friend. Second, I had a "committee" in my head that loved to meet just to throw rebuke, regrets, and resolutions my way (I wasn't about to sit around that conference table!). Third, I seemed very busy, always running somewhere - work, meetings, the store...anywhere but alone with me.

I had already started reading a daily meditation book, even though I didn't read it every day in the beginning. Eventually, I was guided to pages 86-88 in the Big Book that laid out very specific things I could practice everyday. Eventually, as I settled down into a comfortable sobriety, I didn't mind being alone. Not only that, but my "committee" stopped meeting as often. If they did, I learned to say, "I fired you guys! Remember???"

As I grew in sobriety, my meditation became a daily necessity. Today, my morning starts with a daily reading followed by yoga. With each movement and breath, I think about what I have read, the day ahead, my sobriety, and how I need to be that day. I end in a kneeling poise. My mind is clear, enveloped with a silence filled with peace and renewed purpose. In this silence, I feel closest to God. I am ready to be sober today. Anon
