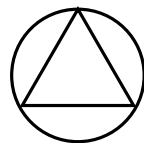

When I finally arrived in the rooms of AA, beaten and bankrupt in the early '90s, this book was there waiting for me. From the most dazed and ragged beginning is evolving an adult who is allowed to live freely in this world as long as I continue to be willing to learn, teach, and grow.

Our local Intergroup office was where my first sponsor took me. (Actually I was afraid to let her out of my sight, so I followed her everywhere!) I am forever grateful that it began 70 years ago and continues to offer love and service opportunities to all of us.

"Each day, somewhere in the world, recovery begins when one alcoholic talks with another alcoholic, sharing experience, strength, and hope."

This is the last paragraph of the foreword to the 3<sup>rd</sup> edition. May it ever be so as long as God would need us. anon

## **Unity, Recovery, Service**

When we first enter the doors of Alcoholics Anonymous, we find ourselves in the midst of a group of people who mysteriously seem to be free of the terrible hold that alcohol has on us. The first thing we want to know is how do they do that?

As I kept listening I begin to grasp a few basics...first, we don't have to do anything for more than one day at a time...in my case it began with 5 minutes at a time. The second thing we see is that the group is united in this effort and seems to have a special way of communicating as they help each other stay focused Unity became my first lesson...staying close to this group of people kept me centered on just not picking up a drink for this one day. I began to understand who these people were as I went to more meetings and saw still others who were doing exactly what I was trying to do...climb out of the bitter pit of despair.

As I made new friends I found that my brain became clear of the mush of active alcoholism. I started to see that lots of people had some indefinable thing that I really wanted for myself.

Starting to understand exactly what I was reading in the books that were thrust upon me from all directions became a joy for me. I even began to understand what I was hearing in meetings. This led me to potential sponsors and teachers who began the difficult job of guiding me on the path that they walked in their quest of sobriety. To be continued...

### ***The A.A. Tradition* The First Tradition**

Each member of Alcoholics Anonymous is but a small part of a great whole. AA must continue to live or most of us will surely die. Hence our common welfare comes first. But individual welfare follows close afterward.

Group unity is the first thing that can attract newcomers to AA. If we are fighting each other for prominence or gain, we cannot effectively carry any message, especially one that will save lives. That important message is that we have a solution that all of us believe in and cherish. Without that there is no group and eventually no AA. Where would we be without our beloved program that keeps us happy, joyous and free? Our common welfare would be shattered, and most of us would be dead or truly wish we were.

### **Random Quote - God's Gifts**

We see that the sun never sets upon A.A.'s Fellowship; that more than three hundred and fifty thousand of us have now recovered from our malady; that we have everywhere begun to transcend the formidable barriers of race, creed, and nationality. This assurance that so many of us have been able to meet our responsibilities for sobriety and for growth and effectiveness in the troubled world where we live, will surely fill us with the deepest joy and satisfaction.

But, as a people who have nearly always learned the hard way, we shall certainly not congratulate ourselves. We shall perceive these assets to be God's gifts, which have been in part matched by an increasing willingness on our part to find and do His will for us.

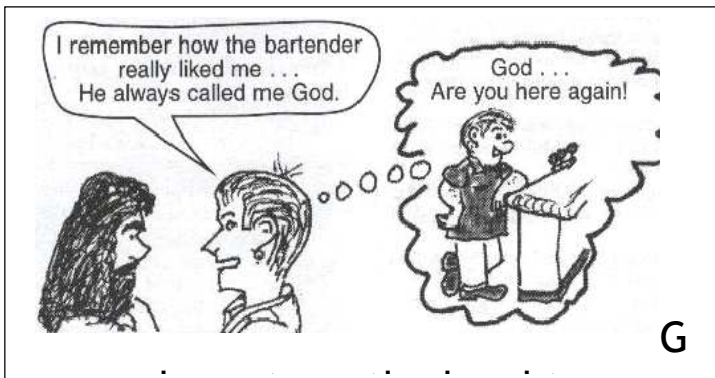

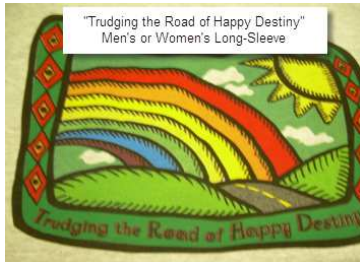
