The idea of faith was something that eluded me most of my life. I found the world was hostile and cruel as Bill W. said. Being pushed and pulled along by others and by life in general caused me to live in great fear, never understanding what was happening or knowing what was going to happen next. This kept me almost paralyzed a great deal of the time.

The solution that I found many years ago was alcohol. It would diminish the fears somewhat and allow me to function in a world where I felt I didn't belong. It's amazing to think of the years and years that went by without my having any idea of who or what I was. Drinking was the only thing I had that made life bearable from day to day.

As with all of us in AA there came a day when it was no longer the answer to anything and became a very grave problem. As our Big Book puts it, I was unable to live with alcohol or without it. Death seemed the only available option. Then a miracle happened when I was led by a series of remarkable circumstances to the rooms of Alcoholics Anonymous. Over the years a Higher Power that I never knew began to work in my life. Today faith fills my days the way alcohol used to.

On page 28 of our book 'Alcoholics Anonymous' it states that: "What seemed at first a flimsy reed, has proved to be the loving and powerful hand of God. A new life has been given us or, if you prefer, "a design for living" that really works."

This is an amazing statement about a truly amazing and life-giving program that saves so many lives and I am so very grateful to be alive and among you all.

### ***The A.A. Tradition***

#### **Tradition Five**

**Each Alcoholics Anonymous group ought to be a spiritual entity *having but one primary purpose*—that of carrying its message to the alcoholic who still suffers.**

Bill W. wrote the following for a Grapevine article in 1958 and it was then published in the pamphlet "Problems other than Alcohol" (#P-35 available at the Intergroup office). Nothing I could say could ever be as powerful as this from our co-founder:

**"Sobriety – freedom from alcohol – through the teaching and practice of the Twelve Steps is the sole purpose of an AA group. Groups have repeatedly tried other activities, and they have failed. It has also been learned that *there is no possible way to make non-alcoholics into AA members.* We have to confine our membership to alcoholics, and we have to confine our groups to a single purpose. If we don't stick to these principles, we shall almost surely collapse. And if we collapse, we cannot help anyone."**
